We're always busy with Bolster Buddies and those guys have had the time of their lives with lots of fun Summer Day Trips and our first ever residential week away up in Portstewart.

We had a super Staff Wellbeing Day mid-August at Elmfield Estate with the amazing Jane Shaw. We've welcomed some new team members (see pg 5) and also said farewell to others – Angela, Sian, Ciara and Sarah, who are all moving onto the next exciting stages of their lives – thanks for everything!

Our social enterprise Acorn Scents had a successful end of summer sale – candles and our new soaps flew out the door – and with Christmas just around the corner, make sure you follow us on socials to be the first to know about our special events and offers! Our beautiful gift boxes would make a fantastic gift (the proceeds from which goes back into supporting our work) so please keep us in mind, no order is too big or small!

In September we attended Patrick Brown MLA's World Suicide Prevention Day event in Stormont. We attended with around 30 other organisations working across mental health, neurodiversity and suicide prevention from across South Down. We appreciate his awareness that it is organisations like ours on the ground, who are helping people day in day out, whilst frustratingly our government remains M-I-A.

Earlier this year, we saw the tangible benefits of Social Value in action when the team at Connect-Transform-Sustain (CTS) came on board (via a 3-way partnership with Women'sTec) to fund a cohort of our Go Girl! Programme, enabling us to take 34 girls through an 8-week personal development programme. And on Friday 6th October, CTS were awarded 'Highly Commended' in the Social Value Category at the CEF Construction Excellence Awards. Everyone wins when Social Value is embraced by the business community. So we'll put the call out now – if there are any progressive businesses out there who recognise the importance of Corporate Social Responsibility and who'd like to look

It's no secret that we have a SILENT DISCO Spooktacular coming up on the 25th October. This is no ordinary event, it puts inclusiveness front and centre with the invite being distributed to all local community, support and social groups in the learning disability and neurodiverse spaces. We really hope it is embraced by the organisations around us, as there really isn't a lot catered to these groups in an over 18's social setting. We created this event in partnership with Newry BID and the PCSP (Policing and Community Safety Partnership) - and forms part of 'Health in the City' month of October, ensuring that our young adults with mixed abilities are included and celebrated, giving them access to what everyone else takes for granted - a good night out! Our CEO Jacinta is passionate about this and rightly so, "We just don't see enough social opportunities for young adults of mixed ability... a SILENT Disco will put inclusiveness centre stage in Newry and provide young people with the chance to combat loneliness and feel socially safe, in a space that everyone else takes for granted. We hope this will be the first of manu!"

And with October also being Downs Syndrome Awareness Month, there's no better time to celebrate and help break down social barriers. Eamonn Connolly, Chair of the Bolster Board and Managing Director of Newry BID agrees, "Halloween is a social highlight for many young people and it's so important that this fun is inclusive and for everyone. Bolster is thrilled to be bringing the first ever inclusive silent disco of this scale to Newry which puts the needs of young adults of mixed abilities and neurodiverse conditions first - and we are delighted to feature it as a key event in Newry BID's 'Health in the City' programme of events. Please feel free to contact the team at Bolster if you are not sure if this is suitable for you or your family member." Councillor Oonagh Hanlon, Chairperson of Newry, Mourne & Down Policing and Community Safety Partnership said, "Newry, Mourne and Down PCSP are committed to supporting opportunities for safe and inclusive events across our district and so we are delighted to be involved in this Silent Disco 'Spooktacular'. This is part of the 'Health in the City' initiative developed by Newry BID and promises to be a great event."



SENIORS SERVICES

Bolster Community are delighted to be extending their services for seniors in the local area (after recently securing funding from The Community Foundation (supported by Bank of Ireland Cost of Living), to provide improved access to services, advice and support for seniors in the Newry, Mourne and Down Area.

Bolster Community have established a social group based in Newry for people over 60. The Clover Club has seen immediate demand and currently has 35 people registered and 4 volunteers supporting the group.

As part of this funding, we have held one of our three community events bringing together older people in the community, to provide information on access to services available - our Discover & Connect events aim to improve access to Community and Voluntary sector resources for those over 60's.
