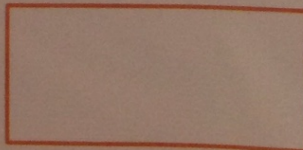
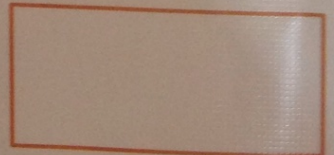

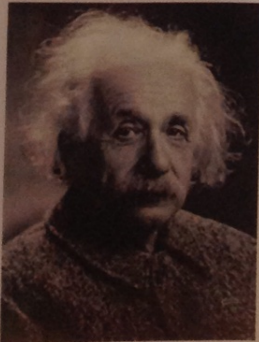

Ways That People Escape ***ON FOOT***

Thousands of people walk 100's of miles. Some people have to carry their babies, others push wheelchairs and some need crutches.
