- Gardens and Flowers




• Farmyard Animals and their young

Suggested activities to carry out with your child at home

- Helping you to hang out the washing and watching how the wind blows it on the line

- Listening to rain and watching raindrops splashing in puddles chat about how it is necessary for plants to grow
- Also discussing with your child how the weather can affect our plans and what we wear

Many of your children are trying to trace their own names. Please try to encourage this at home, paying attention to the capital letter at the beginning of the name followed by lowercase letters.

- Make use of the name card which I have sent home and draw your child's attention to his or her name
- On visits to the shop, look out for Free Range Eggs and see if your child can tell you anything about them
- Try to find duck eggs and look at the size and colour in comparison to hen's eggs
