Suggested Activities to do with your children at home

- To reinforce our focus on transport you might like to point out the different types of vehicles that you see en route to the Nursery
- Talk to your child about and engage in play with some emergency vehicles that he/she might already have. Let your child's imagination take over
- Reinforce the importance of holding hands with an adult while crossing the road and the importance of wearing our seat belts
- Encourage your child to be observant as you point out the Red Man and the Green Man at the pedestrian crossing
- Our colour focus for February is **YELLOW** and we would ask you to help your child find and recognise **YELLOW** items at home. We would ask if your child could bring a **YELLOW** item to school. We would appreciate it if these items were not breakable, suitable for children to play with and that they do not need to be returned. We thank you in advance for your cooperation in adding to our play activities and potential learning

- As many of our children have already turned four years old and as we have many birthdays on the way, we would be appreciative of old birthday cards to cut up and use in the Nursery. The children's birthdays should give you a chance to reinforce counting from 1 to 4 and to talk about numbers 1, 2, 3 and 4. This is a marvellous opportunity to experience early mathematical skills
