Dear Parents,


I write with some practical arrangements for Friday evening's confirmation which will begin at 6.00pm in Newry Cathedral.

- Please be seated in the Cathedral by 5.45 at the latest.
- Pupils and sponsors have been allocated seats but other family members will choose their own seats upon arrival.
- RE photographs: Please tell all members of your family that photographs **MUST NOT** be taken during the ceremony. Photographic opportunities will be available at the end.
- Please be aware that there will be no follow up party in school as we did not have enough replies to
 proceed. This is understandable due to the timing and I wish you a lovely evening with your family,
 however you plan to celebrate.

I hope that you are looking forward to Confirmation, I know that the boys and girls certainly are. They started their preparations earlier in the year with their 'Service of Light' ceremony in which each selected his/her confirmation name. The reverence, thoughtfulness and maturity shown then has continued and augurs well for a very special confirmation on Friday. Your children are a credit to you and our school!

As we make the final arrangements, there are a few suggestions that I would like to share with you to really help your child with his/ her spiritual preparations

- Spend time with him/her working through the sacramental homework this week.
- Talk about the challenges that will emerge in the years to come when he/she will really need to call on the gifts of the Holy Spirit to empower him/her to make the right choices.
- Speak about his/her Saint's name chosen as confirmation name.
- Encourage your child to say his/her prayers each night. Our pupils are very aware spiritually at this stage of their lives.

- Remind your child of the reverence of the day when he/she is in church. This has not been an issue in recent years as our pupils have been so beautifully behaved and 'tuned into' the true significance of their sacrament. - Remind all members of your family of the need for reverence in the church, this has been a cause for concern in previous years.

I thank you in advance for joining us in these final preparations. As with all things, the more preparation he/she, you the parents and we the staff put into the sacrament the more deeply he/she will be touched by it. We love being part of this preparation and we are always so proud of your wonderful children on their special day.
