Seamróga an Iúir is delighted to announce details of its Annual Winter Training Programme. The programme will run for ten weeks, beginning on Sunday 14th October 2018. The cost of the programme is £10 per child, (payable as a one off fee on the first night of registration.) The programme is open to any child who is currently in Primary One or Two.

This year the programme will be based in the Abbey Grammar School INDOOR Sports' Hall. The sessions will begin at 10am and finish at 11am. Parents are asked to bring their child to the Sports Hall with all of the registration details overleaf filled in. Parents mobile numbers will then be added to a 'WhatsApp' group that will post any changes in arrangements that take place from time to time.

This is the sixth year of this Programme and it is hugely popular because it builds on the work being undertaken in Primary Schools with the Ulster GAA scheme. Primary One and Two pupils will be coached by some of our experienced primary school coaches and prominent senior footballers and hurlers, and will include occasional visits from current intercounty GAA Stars. This group will learn the basics of movement and balance as well develop some of the basic skills of Gaelic football and Hurling, through playing fun games, novelty races and structured play.

The feedback about the programme over the years has been fantastic and we are certain that your child will enjoy playing for their local club.

Registration will take place on Sunday 14th Oct from 9:30am, with the sessions beginning at 10am. A registration form must be completed for EVERY CHILD on the programme, even if they have been involved in the summer coaching at Newry Shamrocks or previous programmes.
