## Taking the curriculum outdoors:



## Pupil attendance:

We had a meeting with the Education Welfare Officer on Wednesday. At this meeting she talked through the attendance levels of all pupils who had fallen below 85% across the year to date. She noted that most families who had received a school issued letter in February stating that attendance was causing concern, had improved levels by March. These will be reviewed again in April. She also indicated some families that need to be referred to her service for intervention and will meet with us on a monthly basis to identify other families who may need this.
