
3. Operation Encompass

A letter will be posted on Seesaw alerting you to this pilot programme in which St Clare's Abbey is involved.

We appreciate this, as on too many occasions we were not aware that such a thing had happened, and as such could not make the necessary pastoral arrangements to support our children.

I urge parents to check on their child's tablet or device to check for unsuitable content. I was alerted by a very vigilant P4 parent, to inappropriate content that was accessible via a character that had featured in Fortnight. I urge you to follow the recommendations in the ICT acceptable
