Treating people equally without favouritism or discrimination

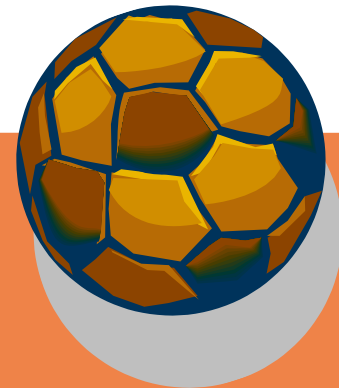


If you are taking part in group work and you have a great idea, don't shout it out, hear other's opinions first.
