Say the sum. Round the numbers and estimate your answer. Remember to check this at the end to see if your estimate was a good guide.

PARTITION - MULTIPLY - ADD

- 1. Partition the number into hundreds, tens and units and put these numbers into the grid.
- 2. Multiply 200 x 40. 200 x 4 = 800. 800 x 10 = 8000.
- 3. Multiply 50 x 40. 50 X 4 = 200. 200 X 10 = 2000.
- 4. Multiply 40 × 6. 4 × 6= 24. 24 × 10 = 240.
- 5. Multiply $200 \times 7 = 1400$, $50 \times 7 = 350$ and $6 \times 7 = 42$, using the same language as above.
- 6. Now add these numbers, being careful to have each number in the correct place value column.
