Application for Free School Meals.



Road safety message

We put a lot of effort into teaching your children about road safety. Please work with us to instil key messages by:





. Crossing the road outside school with the assistance of the 'lollipop man'- Mr Monaghan. The adults on duty have been advised that they should not be helping pupils to cross the road at a different point ie across from the pedestrian gate.

• Ensuring that you use footpaths and zebra crossings when walking through school with your child.

• Dropping your child off in the correct zone (at the section of the turning area close to the P1/2 play park.). NB pupils should never be walking in between parked cars.

Collection of P4-P7 children

Pupils will be brought to the gates for collection. They cannot be taken from their line prior to that by parents or older siblings etc. It is a hectic time of the day and the teacher needs to be very clear that he/she has dismissed each child properly.

Arrangements for sending messages to school

Thank you for signing up to Seesaw. This will be used for teachers to share messages with you and for you to comment on pupils' work or respond to certain queries. HOWEVER if you need to send an urgent message during the day, please do this by contacting the school office. Teachers look at Seesaw only at specific times in the day and can miss these urgent messages. Thank you for working with us on this.

Sacramental dates


